

Alpine Hike from Hut to Hut Widderstein area

A sporty mountain adventure for enthusiastic hikers. This three-day hike from hut to hut leads through the alpine Widderstein region of the Allgäu Alps. The daily stages are demanding. Hiking times range between four and six hours each day and there are several ascents to tackle.

Itinerary



Day 1: From the Hinterbregenzerwald to the Kleinwalsertal valley

The route will take you from Schoppernau through several alpine-rose and bilberry fields up to the Neuhornbachjoch and across the Gerachsattel on to the beautifully situated Schwarzwasser Hütte (1,626 metres).

- Schoppernau – Neuhornbachjoch – Schwarzwasser Hütte
 - Walking time approx 5 h
 - Ascent 1107 m, Descent 320 m
 - Overnight stay in the Schwarzwasser Hütte incl. half board

Day 2 :Through the alpine Widderstein area

Today, you'll be hiking to the idyllic village of Baad in Kleinwalsertal and, at the foot of the mighty Widderstein, on to the Widderstein Hut, which is located at more than 2,000 metres above sea level.

- Schwarzwasser Hütte – Baad – Widderstein Hütte
 - Walking time approx 5 ¼ h
 - Ascent 1059 m, Descent 673 m
 - Overnight stay in the Widderstein Hütte incl. half board

Day 3: Out and about in the Allgäu Alps

The hiking trail will take you through the Koblat Pass to the Mindelheimer Hütte. A spectacular climb to the historic Schrofen Pass awaits. You'll then be making a leisurely descent to Warth in the Bregenzerwald.

- Widderstein Hütte – Schrofenpass – Warth
 - Walking time approx. 5 h
 - Ascent 562 m, Descent 1076 m
